Tokyo — (NC) — Tadahiko Mibuchi, recently retired Chief Justice of the Japanese Supreme Court, was baptized in his home on his 70th birthday by the Rev. Herman Heuvers, S.J., pastor of St. Ignatius church here. His sponsors were Dr. Kotaro Tanaka, his Catholic-convert successor as Chief Justice, and Mrs. Tanaka. Justice Mibuchi's wife and daughter have been Catholics for several years.

The retired Chief Justice has completed two new books, soon to make an appearance. One deals with man and society and the other is a study of democracy.

Such phrases as these are all too familiar. By adding a few paragraphs here and there we could give you a little insight into the many problems which men and women from every economic level bring to Catholic Charities.

We prefer however, to tell you a little about counseling as we see it. Counseling today is a term that is used glibly by business and professions as though it were a product you could buy across a counter. Counselors have their own black market, and their "customers" are not a few. The horror of an American culture, which regards relief agencies as the certain road to dependency continues to haunt the qualified Social Agencies and threaten them with defeat.

CASE WORK or counseling is synonymous with "relief giving" to the point that it isn't respectable to apply to an agency unless your first problem is a lack of funds. Why, in this day of high powered salesmanship and streamlined advertising have we failed so completely in our attempt of interpretation?
