**Statue Buried During War
 Now Stands In Irish Town**

Dublin — (NC)— An 18 foot, three and a half-ton bronze statue of Christ the King which spent the war years buried in France, has just been delivered to the town of Dun Laoghaire, Port of Dublin, to be erected there facing the sea.
 Erected in Paris some 10 years ago just as the war began, the statue was buried on a French farm by a famous bronze founder and covered by a haystack. Thus hidden for six years of the German occupation it escaped harm.
 THEREIN is a bit of interesting history connected with the long story of the statue's travels.
