WITH HOLY WEEK drawing to a close, the Bishop will celebrate the Solemn Pontifical Mass of the Resurrection in the Pro-Cathedral at 11 a. m. At the three hour service from 10 to 12:30, the Bishop will preside and the Rev. Daniel Egan, S. A., noted Praetor of the Movement of Holy Saturday will conduct the services.

On Holy Saturday services beginning at 7 a. m. will consist of the Blessing of the New Fire and of the Paschal Candle, the reading of the Prophecies and the Blessing of the Banquet Water and the Easter Water with Mass following.

The Lenten Fast will end at noon on Holy Saturday, but strict observance of the rules of fast and abstinence is required until noon of Holy Saturday.
