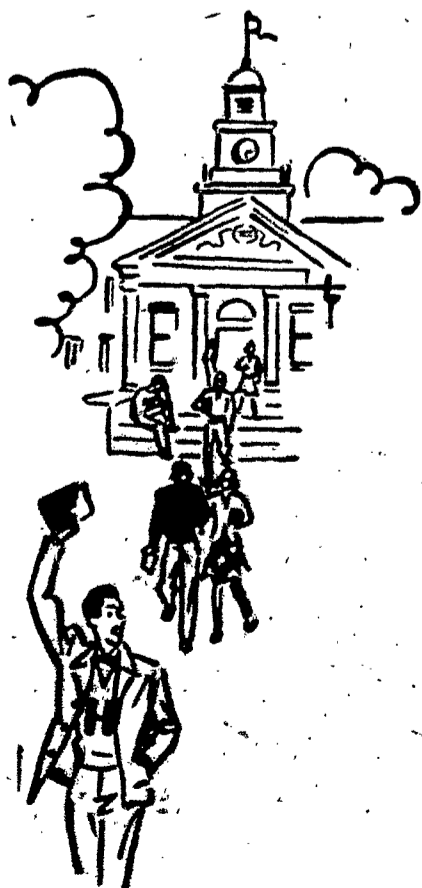

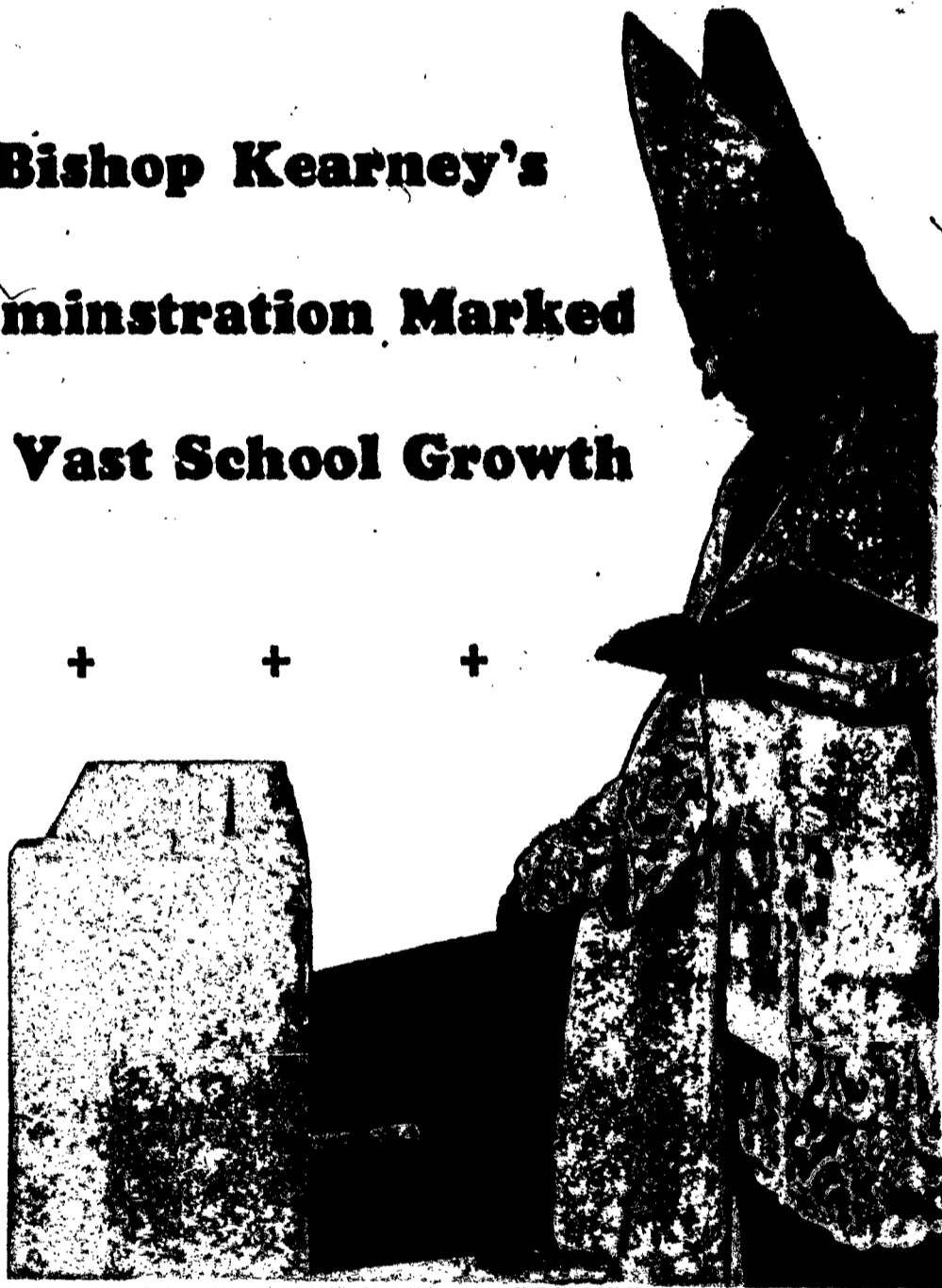

The Educator Bishop!

Bishop Kearney's deepest concern is the religious education of our Catholic youth. Since he became Chief Shepherd of the Diocese of Rochester in 1937 he has sponsored the erection of the new St. Andrew's Seminary, Nazareth College for women, St. John Fisher College for men, the inauguration of St. Agnes High School for girls and the new St. Joseph's Villa for dependent children.

During his regime, six new religious houses of study have been established in the Diocese. They are: St. Michael's Seminary, Conesus; St. John Seminary of the Atonement, Montour Falls; St. Anthony's Seminary, Watkins Glen; Whitefriars Monastery of the Carmelite Fathers, Auburn; the Capuchin Seminary, Geneva, and the Basilian Novitiate, Rochester.

Under Bishop Kearney's guidance and direction elementary education has expanded. Nine new elementary schools have been erected in new parishes with four more in immediate prospect. In addition new school buildings have been added in twelve parishes.

The loyal support which the Faithful of the Diocese of Rochester give to Catholic education shows they are in hearty accord with Bishop Kearney's public declaration that "Catholic Schools stand not only for religion and God, but for patriotism and love of country!"
