**St. John Units Urged To Fight False Ideologies**

Bringing together 500 delegates from seven cities in New York State, a two-day "delegates' meeting" was held by New York Grand Commander of the Knights of St. John and Ladies Auxiliary in Rochester Saturday and Sunday.

The knights and their ladies in resolutions paid tribute to the Holy Father and noted the Holy Year. They went on record in favor of a Good Friday legal holiday in New York State to be marked with reverence and devotion. The knights scored a euthanasia and urged that Christian principles be followed in family life.

Brigadier General Earl E. Boyle of Syracuse and Miss Bertha Kennerknecht of Utica, who presided at the Knights and Ladies sessions, were respectively elected presidents of the two organizations.

With other officers they were installed by Brigadier General Frederick J. Wegman, past Grand Commander, president, and Supreme President Andrew O. Zink, who came from Detroit to observe the meetings.

**HIGHLIGHT OF THE SESSIONS** was a dinner in Hotel Seneca Sunday noon at which Martin Q. Moll, director of public relations (Catholic Courier Journal), was principal speaker.

Moll called his listeners to a "vigorous counter attack against false ideologies, only one of which is Communism." He declared the present world conflict of ideas stems from a denial and rejection of the universal norm of morality and from a disregard of the natural law itself.

Popularity of Catholic books among the general public was cited by the speaker as an indication of how wide is the audience for Catholic ideals. Moll accused Catholics of being "weak
