

The panels are the work of Sculptor Ivan Mestrovic, who ex eguted them over a pertoca of more than 30 years. Most of the panels are six feet tail and four to nine feet wide The series carved in American, French and Yugoslavian walnut traces the life of Jesus from "The Annin ciation" through "The Ascen sion "

Six of the panels were done by Mestrovic, who was described by Rodin as "the greatest phenomenuli among sculptors," in Switzerland during World War I. Six more were executed in Zagreb. Yugoslavia, at the beginning of the Second World War. The remaining 13 were completed in Syracuse

Mestrovic, who has refused to return to Yugoslavia, his homeland, because he feels freedom has gone from that nation, is now aculptor in residence at Syr
