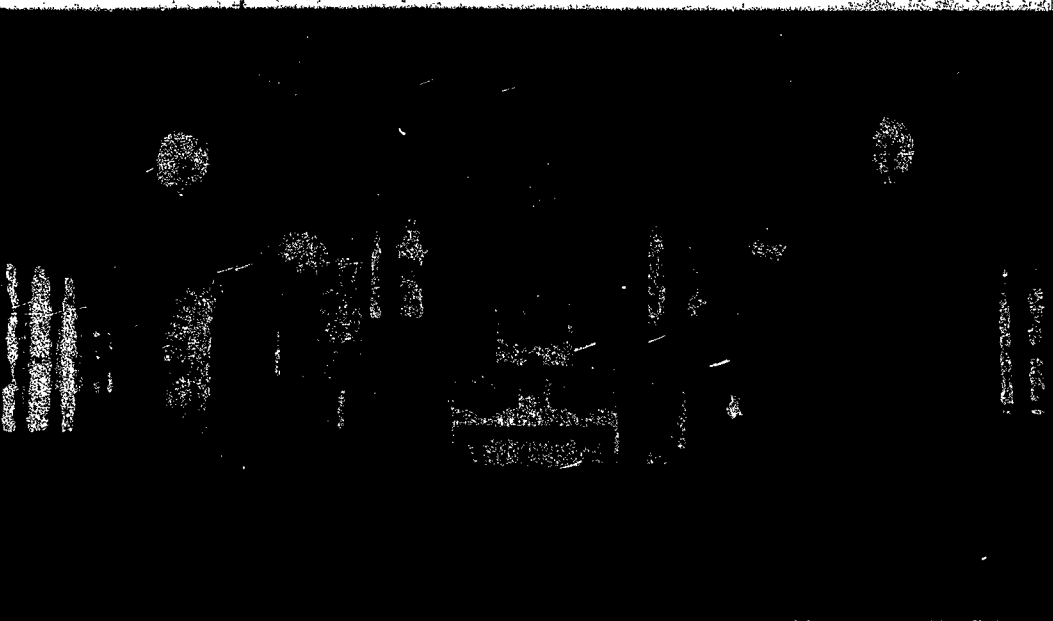
SIGNALIZING THE tribute to Mary will be a colorful procession of standard bearers, altar boys and white-clad children from the second and third grades of St. Anne's school.
