A modern dock is so divided that each type of swimmer has his own section in which to play safely. The beginners are referred to a large area where the water is just the right depth for them, and they can more easily learn to float and kick without fear.

The intermediates have their own section which offers an even greater challenge while the advanced swimmers can enjoy their diving and snorkeling in depths in keeping with their abilities.

AMERICAN RED CROSS Life Guards supervise all the camps during swim time. They conduct lessons for each group. Their aim is always to send a boy home a better swimmer and diver than when he came to camp.

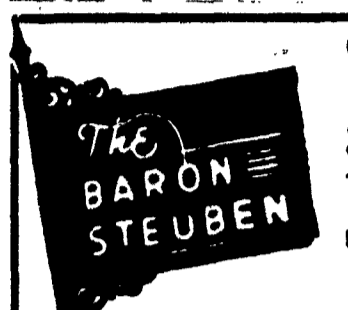
