Margaret Klem Is Honored By Citation At UR Rites

Miss Margaret C. Klem, member of a well known Rochester Catholic family, was one of 13 graduates of the University of Rochester honored with special citations in recognition of notable achievements presented by the University as part of its centennial celebration Saturday evening (June 10).

Miss Klem who practiced law in Rochester for several years after her admission to the Bar in 1924, moved to Washington and has become one of the nation's leading medical economists. Her studies some years ago in the field of prepayment medical care plans are still classics in this now important area.

Long prominent in Rochester Catholic circles, Miss Klem's family is also responsible for one of the legends of the Church in upper New York State.

In 1918, Bernard Klem accompanied his mother, Anna Maria Klem on a 40-day walking trip to New York City to have his sister baptized, the family records show.

Miss Klem has worked in almost every state in the union on voluntary health insurance plans and other medical programs, beginning with her work in 28 states in connection with a study on the family costs of illness for the Committee on Costs of Medical Care of 1928-1931.

For the past ten years she has written a column for the Catholic Charities Review on new publications in the medical care field.
