

### Liberty Bell To Sound Opening

The three ringing tones which proclaimed America's freedom throughout the land on a July day in 1776 will be heard in Rochester next Wednesday, June 21.

An exact replica of the original Liberty Bell, authentic even to sound will come to Rochester to highlight the U. S. Savings Bonds "Independence Drive" in this area.

The bell, which weighs over 2,000 pounds, is one of 52 exact copies which will tour the United States and American territories until July 4, when a bell will be loaned permanently to each state and possession.

After visiting local plants on Thursday, the Bell will tour surrounding towns and villages on Friday before leaving for Batavia and Buffalo.

### St. Bona Men Hear Friar Urge 'World' Repudiation

Their lives should be a repudiation of what the pagan world stands for, 350 St. Bonaventure College alumni, students and fathers were told by the Rev. Jerome A. Kelly, O.F.M., at their third annual Communion Breakfast in Seneca Hotel, Sunday.

Father Kelly, director of the college's English Department and a member of the National Council of Teachers of English celebrated the Mass in Old St. Mary's Church at which the group received Holy Communion in a body.

The world, the Franciscan Friar explained, is today emphasizing sensuality, greed and selfishness. Opposing these the Christian and Catholic will bring upon himself enmity, hostility and deep hatred.

"YOU REALLY have to pay with your blood to follow in the footsteps of Jesus Christ," the noted educator said. He cited the names of Mindszenty, Steinhilber and Bern as symbols of present day sacrifices for the faith.

The alumni, students and their fathers were welcome at Old St. Mary's Church by the Rev. Elmer W. Hetland, assistant pastor. Gerard Sullivan presided as toastmaster at the breakfast. Heard also were Robert J. Kohler, alumni group president and William Bennett, 1950 class president.
