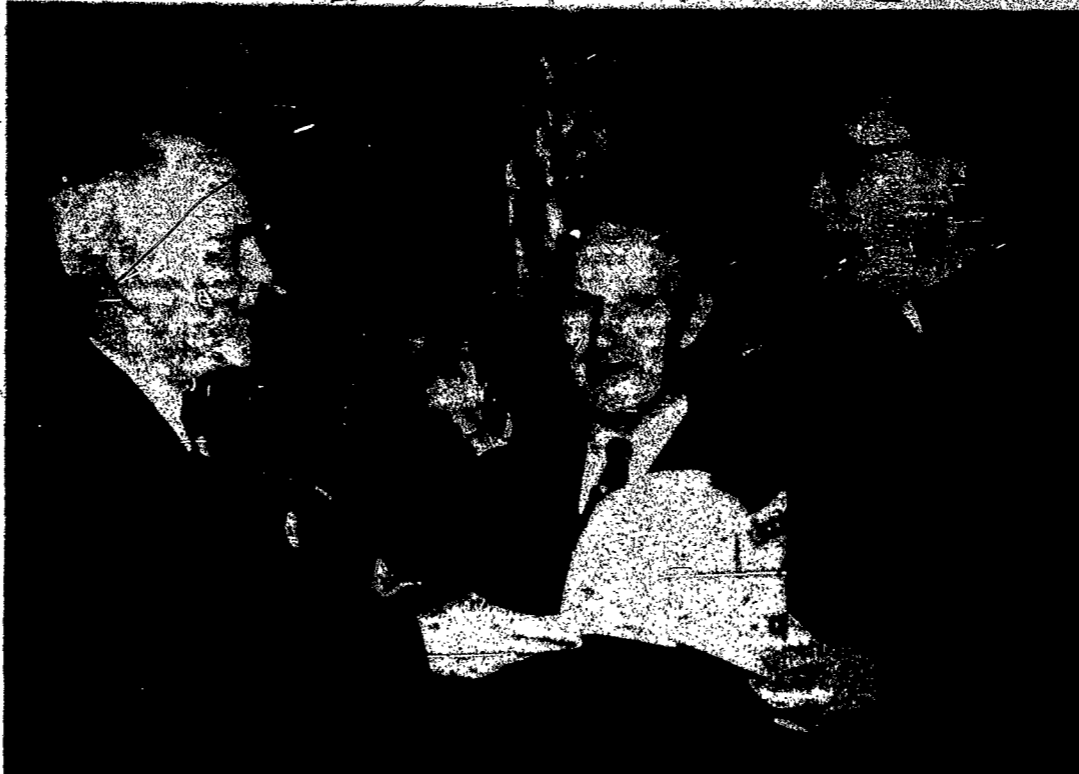
**Webster HN Plan
