

### Blood Donor Unit At St. Andrew's

The Mobile Unit of the Rochester Regional Red Cross Blood Program will be set up at St. Andrew's Hall, 923 Portland Avenue from 2:00 until 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 11.

Frank Lange, chairman of this mobile unit visit, enthusiastically stated today, "We intend to double the number of donors recruited in this ward last summer. We look for 175 people to give blood on Tuesday."

Lange is being assisted by Mr. Clarence Grove. The boy scouts in this ward are cooperating with the blood chairman by distributing blood publicity material from house-to-house.

The Mobile Unit's visit to the 22nd Ward is one of a large number of summer visits to the city wards. Plans shaped to resemble a lifesaving drop of transfusion blood will be given to all blood donors Tuesday.

Any person who has given blood since the beginning of the Red Cross Blood Program in January, 1948, is eligible to receive a pin and may do so by presenting his donor card on Tuesday.

### CDA Chairman Grade Studies To Be Rewritten



The honor of selling St. Michael's College summer season at Winookil Park, Vt., the secret of "Making a Workshop Work" fell this week to Rev. Arthur M. Leary, secretary of education, for the diocese of Ogdensburg.

The experience of the five northern New York dioceses in pooling their educational resources was outlined by Father Leary who was a public school teacher for six years before becoming a priest.

Teachers from the diocese of Albany, Buffalo, Ogdensburg, Rochester and Syracuse have begun to rewrite the courses of study in the elementary grades.

Father Leary said, "I was a very much relieved man this year," he said, "when we were informed that the New York State Board of Regents had changed some of its requirements. It's been my conviction that they had often stressed factual knowledge to the detriment of meaningful living. We must never forget we are teaching children and not subjects."

### Father Naughton Bid Farewell by 500

Spiritual and material gifts were presented in appreciation to the Rev. William J. Naughton as pastor of St. Peter and Paul's Church on his leaving Elmira to take up duties as pastor of St. Anne's Church, Rochester.

Parishioners of St. Peter and Paul's received Holy Communion at the Masses June 25 as a spiritual bouquet to the pastor who in five years had made an outstanding record, chief of which was reception of 160 converts since the Perpetual Novena to Mother Cabrini was begun in 1946.

A FAREWELL PARTY attended by more than 500 parishioners was held June 25 in the parish school hall.

On behalf of the parish members, a television set was presented to Father Naughton by Jerry Van Benotien, Holy Name Society president. In the name of Priests and Sisters at St. Peter and Paul's, a set of vestments made by the Carmelite Sisters in Rochester was presented by the Rev. Joseph G. Merkel, assistant pastor.

From the children, Lawrence Sheahan, 11, presented a picture of the king and queen of the recent Mardi Gras children's festival. A large cake, decorated with a depiction of a chalice and Host was given by the Frisk Pastry Shop.

Tribute to Father Naughton and a detailed report of his five years as pastor at the Elmira "mother church" was contained in the June 25th edition of "The Chimes" parish publication.

Editorially "The Chimes" said in part: "Not only the people of St. Peter and Paul's, but all Elmira has received with deep regret the news that Father Naughton is leaving us. That the transfer of a priest from one parish to another should meet such widespread sorrow is unusual, but

that this should be true in Father Naughton's case is neither surprising nor hard to explain.

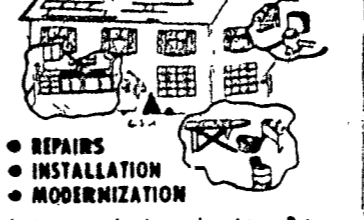
As pastor of the mother church of Elmira, he has seen the spiritual and material growth of our parish and has been most instrumental in that growth.
