Pope Asks Public Prayer, Penance For True Peace

Vatican City (Radio) — His Holiness Pope Pius XII today issued an Encyclical Epistle calling for public prayers and works of penance to placate God, who is offended by grave private and public crimes, and to petition a truce peace for the world.

The epistle is entitled "Summi Materis" (the greatest sorrow), from its opening words in Latin. "WHILE THE sky is overcast with dark clouds," the Pontiff said, "We who have the freedom, dignity and prosperity of all na-

Encyclical Letters, Epistles Explained

Vatican City — (NC) — The term "encyclical letter" is used for papal pronouncements predominantly doctrinal in character; while the term "encyclical epistle" is applied to a papal circular which is rather an exhortation concerning particular events, needs or depositions.

In making this distinction here, Vatican officials noted that an encyclical letter is generally quite lengthy, very solemn in tone and detailed in content. An encyclical epistle, on the other hand, is usually a much shorter document.

First American Priest Jailed In Red China

Tokyo, Japan — (NC) — The first American Catholic missionary to be imprisoned under the communist regime has been reported from south-central China. The priest, a veteran of more than 20 years missionary service, was jailed June 28th on fictitious and ridiculous charges, and has been held incommunicado ever since.

The name of the missionary is not mentioned in the report, possibly out of fear that further arrests among the missionaries might follow any publicity that he gives to his case of false arrest.

It is estimated that a total of 30 or more non-American priests are at present in prisons in Red China. Some are serving sentences that have been imposed, but most of them have simply been detained, some without being informed as to the reasons for their seizure.

Because of slow and uncertain communications it is difficult to ascertain the exact number of Catholic priest foreign and native, held by Red authorities. The imprisonment of the American priest preceded the announcement of the "anti-American" campaign work in China which started on July 17.

Vatican Strikes At Preversion Of Youth

Vatican City, — July 29 (Radio) — The Holy See has struck again with spiritual weapons at the communist menace.

The Sacred Congregation of the Holy Office, in a Monition (warning) published today, excommunicates those who pervert Christian youths in communist youth organizations, and bars from reception of the Sacraments not only the boys and girls who are members of such organizations but also their parents or guardians who allow them to enroll in them.

These communist practices consist in a systematic effort to de-Christianize and demoralize youth. Clubs, associations and summer camps are formed where young boys and girls are encouraged to ridicule priests and religion and to flout Christian teachings and morals.

THE DOCUMENT lists three specific categories of persons and two penalties. One, parents or guardians of children who allow them to join such organizations; Two, those who train children contrary to Christian faith and morals; Three, boys and girls who belong to such organizations.

Persons in categories one and three cannot be admitted to the Sacraments. Persons in category two incur excommunication reserved "in a special way" to the Holy See.

People Following Clergy, Reds Say

London — (RNS) — In a broadcast over the Budapest Radio a Hungarian government spokesman complained that large masses of the people are still following the leadership of the Roman Catholic clergy.

"Despite continued propaganda aimed at the enlightenment of the people," the spokesman said, "a great number of them, particularly peasants, show signs of still being under the influence of reactionary, anti-Communist priests."

Girard, Pa. — (NC) — Sister Marian Augustine Noble of the Maryknoll Sisters, has arrived in Wailua on Oahu Island, Hawaii, to take over teaching duties at a mission post, according to advices received here. Four years ago, Sister Marian was Patricia Noble, daughter of Mr and Mrs Edward F. Noble of Girard and was studying at the University of Pittsburgh. She became interested in the Catholic faith, was received into the Church and joined the Maryknoll community. Her father, mother and brother are non-Catholics.
