Fr. Cirincione To Take Rosary Bouquet to Fatima

Bearing a spiritual bouquet of three million Rosaries, the Rev. Joseph Cirincione, pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Church, Rochester, will leave New York City Wednesday, Aug. 9, for his third pilgrimage to Rome and the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, Portugal.

World peace and the conversion of Russia are the intentions of the Rosary bouquet which "Father Joe," widely-known founder of the Family Rosary for Peace radio broadcast in Rochester Diocese, will present at the Fatima shrine on the anniversary of one of Our Lady's famed apparitions to three children there in 1917. The spiritual bouquet of Rosaries includes those offered on the nightly broadcasts. Father Cirincione will be spiritual director of a group of 16 lay persons making the pilgrimage by air. In a similar capacity will be the Rev. Paul Tanner, assistant general secretary of the executive department of the National Catholic Welfare Conference in Washington, D. C. The Rochester priest expects to repeat visits he has had with Sister Lucy, Carmelite nun who is the sole survivor of the children to whom Our Lady appeared. The visits are made possible through the priest's friendship with Archbishop Manuel da Silva, head of the Propagation of the Faith Society in Portugal and advisor of Sister Lucy. The pilgrimage includes stops in Rome including an audience journey through Spain, four days at Lisbon, Fatima, a three-day visit with the Holy Father, and visits in Northern Italy, Switzerland and the Shrine at Lourdes in France. Father Cirincione will leave the pilgrimage at this point; return to Spain for a two-week stay at Fatima.
