

U. S. Socialists Hear Pope; Boy Scouts Enter Rome

Vatican City — (NC) — His Holiness Pope Pius XII told 900 U. S. pilgrims connected with the Sodality of Our Lady that the sodality is an "effective means for spreading the kingdom of Christ."

He expressed hope that the sodality and the Church's work might both prosper under the care and inspiration of Our Lady.

THE HOLY FATHER addressed the group in St. Peter's Basilica where they occupied a place of honor among some 20,000 pilgrims from various parts of the world. The U. S. pilgrimage is sponsored by the Queen's Work of St. Louis, U. S. headquarters office of the Sodality of Our Lady.

The Pontiff spoke in English to the American pilgrims and then spoke in five other languages for the benefit of other pilgrims, extending to them his welcome and his blessing on their loved ones and their sick at home.

The Holy Father appeared rested and refreshed by his first few days at the papal summer villa at Castelgandolfo. He smiled broadly, waved greetings and extended his hand in blessing in response to the cheers of the pilgrims.

THE PILGRIMS represented 46 of the 49 states, Hawaii,

Alaska and Cuba. Among them are 65 priests and approximately 200 Sisters. Bishop Hickey led the pilgrimage to the four patriarchal basilicas for the Holy Year indulgence. The group was scheduled to leave Sunday morning for Paris.

As the Sodality pilgrims began filing into St. Peter's for the general audience, another U. S. group, 21 Catholic scouts, arrived at Rome's central station. They are headed by the Rev. George Dowd, national director of the Catholic Committee on Scouting.

Priests, Nuns Are Active Radio 'Hams'

Ecuador Chapel To Be Built Through Local Woman's Will

Construction of a chapel in earthquake-torn Ecuador, South America, will be undertaken soon through funds set aside in the will of a Rochester woman.

Arrangements for carrying out the bequest were announced this week by the Very Rev. John S. Randall, director of the diocesan Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

Donor of the chapel was the late Miss Estelle Walzer of Blessed Sacrament parish who died Aug. 28, 1949. Her will provided \$1,000 to the Propagation Society for construction of a chapel in any part of the world where members of the Walzer family would be remembered in all the Masses celebrated in it.

DECISION to erect the chapel in Ambato, a city of some 20,000 population in Ecuador, followed an appeal from Bishop Bernardino, O.F.M., of that area for aid from U. S. Catholics.

Catholic church properties in that area of Ecuador suffered destruction totaling \$40,000,000 from last year's earthquake. So broad was the demolition, that some 8,000 lives, that Masses since that time have been celebrated out of doors.

William Reardon in secular life, and a native of Holyoke, Mass., he first tried to enter the Franciscan brotherhood in New York when he was 48, but was turned down then as being too old. He reapplied, in Washington 10 years later in 1945 and was accepted.
