Family Rosary Reports New Gifts For Radio Expenses

Individual contributions of \$555, plus a \$200 gift from the Sisters of St. Joseph of the diocese and \$148 from the parishioners of St. Joseph of the Family Rosary for Peace this week.

The Family Rosary program, a radio-recitation of the Rosary for the intention of world peace is heard nightly at 10 p.m. on WSAJ, Rochester, and each Sunday evening at 10 o'clock on a diocesan-wide network through Rochester, Geneva, Auburn, Elmira and Hornell stations.

Now in its 24th week of consecutive evening broadcasts, the program has recently made a diocesan-wide appeal for funds to underwrite annual expenses of close to \$16,000.
