Family Rosary Reports New Gifts For Radio Expenses

Individual contributions of \$355, plus a \$200 gift from the Sisters of St. Joseph of the diocese and \$148 from the parishioners of St. Bridget's Church, Rochester, added \$653 to the "Sponsors' Fund" of the Family Rosary for Peace this week.

The Family Rosary program, a radio-recitation of the Rosary for the intention of world peace is heard nightly at 10 p.m. on WDAY, Rochester, and each Sunday evening at 10 o'clock on a diocesan-wide network through Rochester, Geneva, Auburn, Elmira and Hornell stations.

Now in its 24th week of consecutive evening broadcasts, the program has recently made a direct-mail appeal for funds to underwrite annual expenses of close to \$10,000. Generous returns in the first weeks of the fund-drive have slackened recently, the program's executive committee stated in urging more contributors to support the program's maintenance.

Crowds of 75 to 100 people gather to participate in the Rosary each evening as the prayers are broadcast from the outdoor shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary at 493 Orange Street on the grounds of St. Anastasi Church, Orange Street, parallel with Jay Street, can be reached by turning one block south off Jay at Child or Whitney Streets.

Church For Indians Built In Four Weeks

San Diego, Calif. — (NC) — A fast construction work was achieved when the new Church of the Immaculate Conception for the Los Coyotes Indian reservation in the Sierra Mountain range was built from foundation to finish in four weeks.

The Rev. Genaro Carrillo, who has a chain of six Indian churches in the district, served as architect, engineer, contractor and foreman. Brother John F. S.C.J., did the work of a skilled mechanic.

Men of the Los Coyotes reservation organized by Chief Banning Taylor assisted the three builders. A sum of \$1,000 was donated by the Marquette League.

The Jubilarian is Sister Jane LeFrois, S.Sp. S., whose early education was received at Sacred Heart Academy here.

IN THE CHAPEL adorned in silver simplicity, Sister Jane renewed her vows on July 6. The ceremony was conducted by his Excellency, the Most Rev. A. A. Noer, S.V.D., assisted by the Rev. Charles G. Erb, S.V.D., whose home, also in Rochester.

Two other Missionary Sister Servants of the Holy Ghost made their final profession at the ceremony before Holy Mass, Sister Maryelara and Sister Gerard. A group of the native school children sang Latin and vernacular songs during the Mass and for the Benediction following.

Throughout the day the children joined in the celebration. Junior and senior girls vied with one another in presenting original letters and songs. Entertainers were rewarded with a tea party which ended in their being given a half holiday.

SEVERAL TIMES during the day Sister Jane was seen delving through the pile of mail that had poured in from across the sea. Letters, beautiful cards, donations, gifts, all made her wish, she said that "time was not a thief so that she could answer each benefactor individually."

The Jubilarian expressed her deep gratitude to those on this side of the ocean for their thoughtfulness which added to her joy, "benefitted the missions, and made her grateful to the good God who gave her so many friends and relatives after the pattern of his own generosity."
