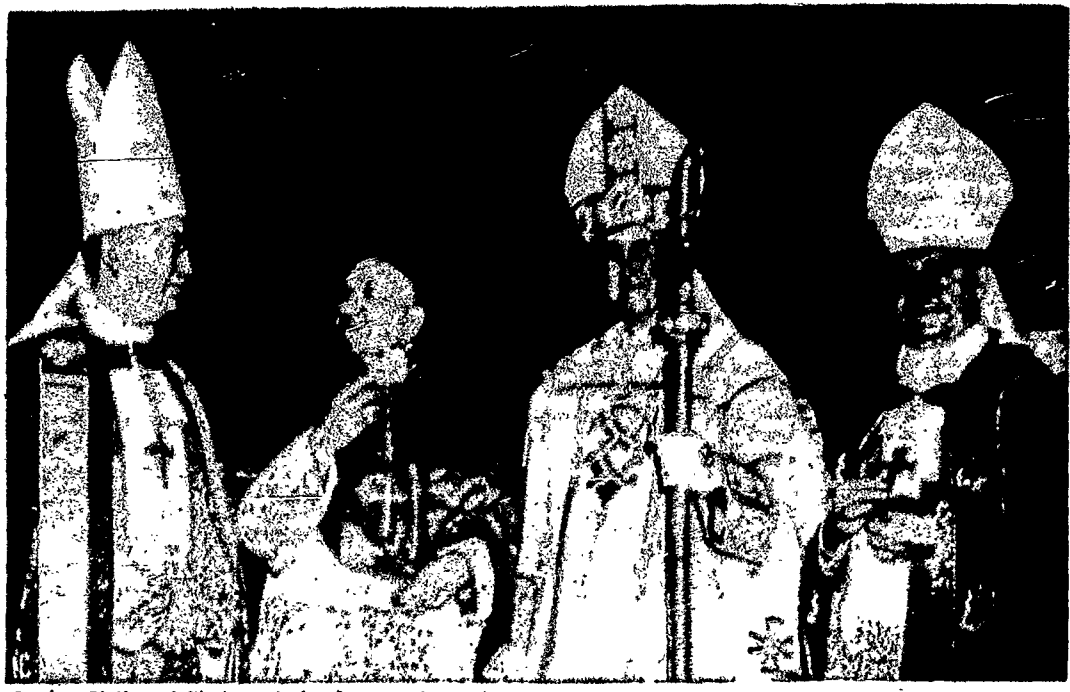
Father McDonnell Farewell Slated
