

### Religion Saves Boys Sent To Industry Says Fr. Vogt

Hershey — "The aim to bring out the best in delinquent boys and to foster the development of virtue by making religion a major part of their lives has been proven by the fact that 70 percent of all boys admitted to industry are actually saved."

This was told by the Rev. Joseph E. Vogt, Catholic Chaplain of the New York State Agricultural and Industrial School, Industry to student nurses at St. James Mercy Hospital, here.

Father Vogt's lecture sponsored by the Sodality of Our Lady of

Lourdes was the first in a series of 10 monthly lectures to be given to the students.

INTRODUCED BY the Rev. John Healy, socially moderate, Father Vogt declared that many of the boys committed to industry "return to society healthy in mind and heart and have become prominent and useful citizens."

"To accept boys as they are and to make them what they should be, is the primary aim at industry," said Father Vogt.

"The institution is a little village in itself, having 400 inhabitants, 41 percent Catholic boys with ages ranging from 12 to 18 years. The institution is situated a few miles south of Rochester and covers an estimated area of four and a half miles, having its own post office, farm, hospital, homes or cottages for the boys, and 100 acres of land."

"Each cottage," he continued, "has living accommodations for 25 boys governed by a house mother and father. The boys are under constant supervision and the virtue of charity reigns supreme."
