

### Belle Arts Prom Set At Nazareth

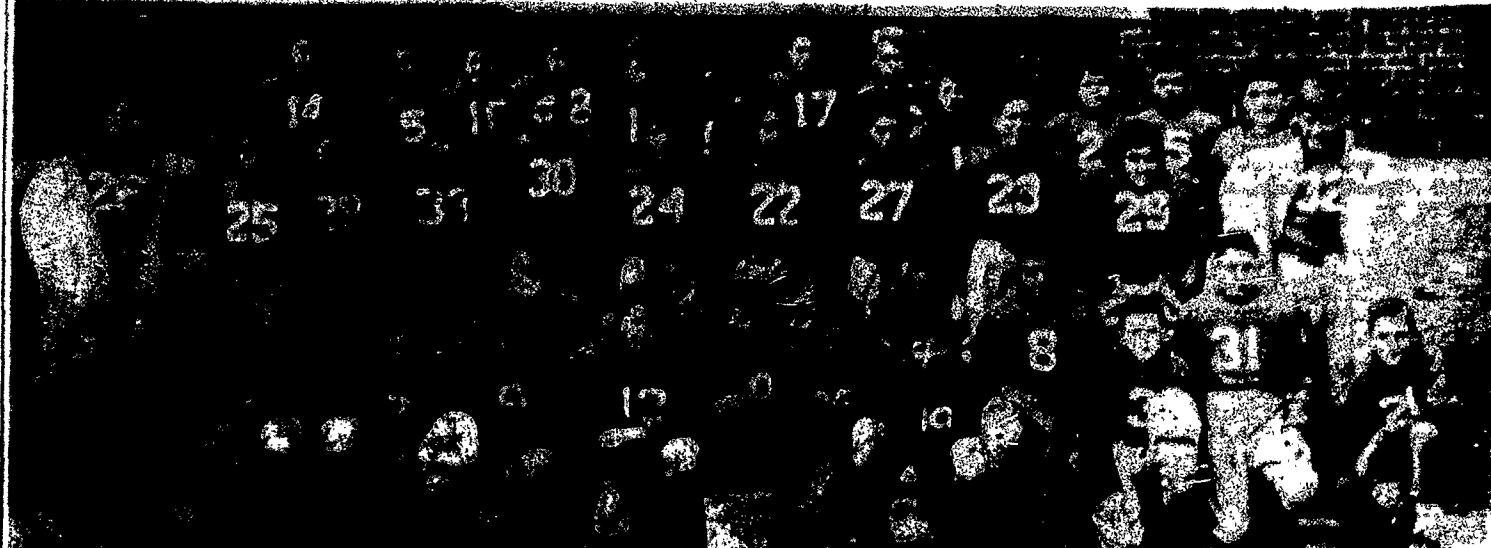
