Abolition of Segregation In Parish Schools Urged

"The strongest force for combating race prejudice," the Monsignor said, "is religion—the Catholic religion."

He said when whites and Negroes kneel together they learn "to love their neighbor for the love of God." He declared that religion "will do what no personal ethical code can do."

Monsignor Drew long has been active in the work of combating racial prejudice and securing social justice for minorities. He formerly was pastor of St. Augustine's Church, an interracial parish. He said that when the parish became interracial and there was no segregation, most of the difficulties anticipated by older parishioners did not materialize.

WHITE AND Negro children attended the same school, he said, and came to know and like each other. There was not a single unpleasant incident at 'teen-age parish dances, at bridge parties and other interracial parish activities.

"There is no particularly great difficulty in getting the cooperation of school children," Monsignor Drew said, "because children know no color line."

Innocent Deported To Soviet Union

Brussels, Belgium (NY) — A picture of thousands of innocent Hungarian citizens being deported to the Soviet Union is presented in a letter received here from Hungary.

The letter received by a member of a religious community states that communist police are entering homes in Hungary without advance notice and ordering entire families to prepare to leave in a few hours. Old and young are then brutally hauled away to an unknown destination in the Soviet Union, while local communists take over the home and belongings, the letter states.

Cornelius J. Milliken, prominent Elmira Catholic layman was the breakfast speaker. In his talk he stressed "the great need for men of high moral standards to help their fellow men in this confused world."

The urgent need of Faith was cited as a means of combating the disease of secularism which has bred insecurity, both spiritually and materially.

"Individuals and Nations, through lack of Faith, have too often sought the answer to moral and social problems in decaying political ideals rather than in God's Law," continued the speaker.

URGING AN ACTIVE Laity through Holy Name Society programs, Milliken pointed out that "faith is a gift, given to us as members of the Catholic family, and unless we encourage faith, we can lose it. This encouragement of Faith should stem from the laity through such groups as this, as well as the clergy."

Concluding, Milliken reminded his listeners, "not only are we obligated to advance the Faith, but we must be prepared to answer those who seek to pervert the teachings of the Church and"
