**Aquinas Whips Manlius To Crown Undeclared Season**

A crashing, muddy 27-7 victory over highly-touted Manlius Military Academy on Thanksgiving Day gave Aquinas Institute its first undefeated season since 1931 and established the Little Irish as the cream of Eastern high school prep-school athletes.

A chilly crowd of 18,500 in Memorial Stadium saw one of the best conditioned and coordinated teams in Aquinas history pour through the heavier Cadet line at will and rack up drives totalling 330 yards against the visitors' 173 yards.

Leading 15 to 7 in first down the Irish were never threatened after Jim Campagna put the contest on ice with a brilliant 85 yard touchdown dash when the game was six minutes old.

THE MANLIUS record of six wins and one tie against college freshmen teams could not save the Aquinas striking power nor penetrate the charging Irish line. Never rolling till the last quarter when Aquinas employed third and fourth stringers, the Cadets were not as impressive as Bulls Prep.

One of the most spectacular team-performances of the year was a win that cemented the victory was expected to lead to a "home game bid" in the South during the Christmas season. Hopes for an invitation to the Peanut Bowl in Columbus, Ga., were dashed this week when the Irish learned that private schools
