

**N. Y. Archdiocese Sets New Buildings**  
 New York (AP)—A \$25,000,000 building program for the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New York was announced today by the Rt. Rev. McGrath, archbishop of the Archdiocese.  
 Thirty-one separate projects, new under way or planned, are included in the program. Among them are churches, hospitals, convents, and children's homes.  
 In making the announcement, McGrath said that an earlier \$25,000,000 project instituted by the Archdiocese in 1947 was now almost finished.  
 Completion schedules for the new project, he said, will be determined by the availability of materials. However, a member of the Archdiocesan Building Commission said later that it was expected the work would be largely finished by the end of 1952, and that some advance planning had been done for the future.

**The Reds—What Now?**  
**How To Be An Anti-Communist**

 In the dying days of the old year, new reasons arose for patriotic Americans to become more intelligently active against communism. The Reds themselves, by their acts at that time, reminded us that the civilian defense apparatus is not enough. There must be an intensification in every town and hamlet of well-informed counter-propaganda against the concealed Stalinist ideas smuggled into the local organizations.

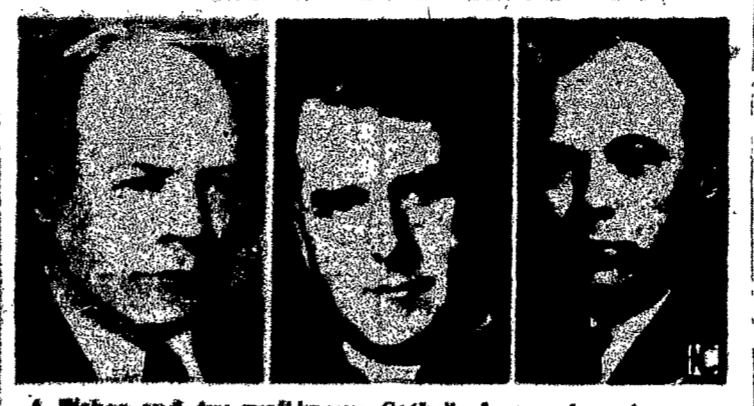
Most of us know by now that from December 28 to 31, the Communist Party held its fifteenth national convention in New York. But few Americans are aware that this convention, dedicating itself to the complete defeat of the United States by the Soviet dictatorship, penetrated every part of the United States, including the rural areas.

How could Americans be fully advised of this new infiltration plot, since the communists met behind locked doors with guards preventing any entrance to their meeting place?  
 What gives us the warning signal, above all, is the new drive decided on by this conspiratorial concave, to accompany national wide infiltration. It is nothing more nor less than a new "third party", or "people's coalition", clamor. And whenever the Reds go in for that, they lay the ground work by a barrage of cleverly phrased press comments through their concealed members and sympathizers, designed to spoon up American public opinion.

**ANTI-RED INFORMATION**  
 Large sections of the secular press have fallen down completely in any intelligent battle against the Soviet fifth column. Every person of fairly good education has at hand sources of information which he or she can use to combat Red infiltration and Red propaganda in local communities.  
 In Washington, the House Committee on Un-American Activities has published a series of studies on subversive organizations, including the National Lawyers Guild, which are invaluable. These studies can be obtained by writing to the Committee at the Old House Office Building, Washington, D. C. Through that source or through the Department of Justice, a full list of the organizations declared subversive by the Attorney General also can be secured.  
 With such information, the anti-communist can begin to spot in his community those who are aiding and abetting Soviet Russia by their support or membership in these subversive groups.

The much energy has been devoted, and I may say wasted, by futile gestures at learning if certain suspected individuals are Red-carrying communists. This way of going about things leads nowhere. Many communists have had no cards at all on any other real signs of membership. Beyond that, the crucial thing to discover is who is aiding the Soviet fifth column's efforts through communist front activities and through spreading the line of thought the Kremlin wants advanced. Sometimes he can do these things much better by not having a party card.  
 For a week to week checkup on the Red fronts, whose names are changed from time to time in order to deceive, it is essential that every library have the issues of Counterattack. **NEW REDFRONT GROUPS**

 "Thirdly, there will inevitably be differences and misunderstandings, perhaps quarrels, perhaps the hurts that go very deep."
