Mrs. Curtin Named To Head National NCCW Committee

The Board of Directors of the National Council of Catholic Women has announced the appointment of Mrs. Frank T. Curtin of Rochester as the National Chairman of the Committee on Organization and Development. NCCW. The appointment was made at the recent annual meeting of NCCW Board of Directors Feb. 5 to 7 at their Washington D.C. headquarters. Mrs. Curtin attended as NCCW director from the Province of New York.

As chairman of the Committee on Organization and Development, Mrs. Curtin in cooperation with all diocesan and Deanery Chairmen will try to secure the affiliation of all parish and inter-parish organizations of the dioceses of the United States. In effect the Committee is the sales force of the Diocesan and National Councils.

Other objectives of the Committee are to intensify and promote Catholic action as well as to unify, coordinate and stabilize programs and collect information on programs in operation. The aim is to bring about a general consciousness on the part of the various affiliated units of belonging to a united body of Catholicity participating in the work of the hierarchy of the United States.

The new national chairman is a past president of the Rochester Diocesan Council, NCCW and of the Catholic Women's Club. Currently, Mrs. Curtin is also editor of The Counsellor, monthly news sheet of the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women.

Rules For Resolutions

Frequently members of Catholic organizations are exhorted to pass a resolution or some controversial issue and then send a copy of the resolution to the proper public official, newspaper or organization interested in the issue. A very practical objection to this idea has been presented to me twice within the past few weeks. There are very few English curricula which include the teaching of such specialized writing as that of resolutions.

For certain formal occasions a resolution is fitting. Is it customary in many organizations to draw up a set of resolutions upon the death of a member. However, in many instances, such as writing a radio station manager to commend certain programs or writing an Association of Commerce to notify it of an organization's desire to have places of business closed during certain sacred times, a well written, sincerely phrased letter might carry more weight by virtue of its straightforwardness.

However, if a resolution is called for a few general rules might be appropriately reviewed. It is customary to open each reason for the decision (the resolution) of the club with the word "whereas." Each reason is set off in a separate paragraph which ends with a semicolon, the final one concluding with a comma.

THE DECISION of the group is introduced by the phrase "Be it resolved" if more than one conclusion or decision has been reached, each one is set off in a separate paragraph, the second and subsequent ones being introduced by the phrase "Be it further resolved." Each paragraph is concluded with a semicolon, the final one terminating of course, with a period.

The resolution bears in the lower right hand side of the page after the last line the signatures of the group.
