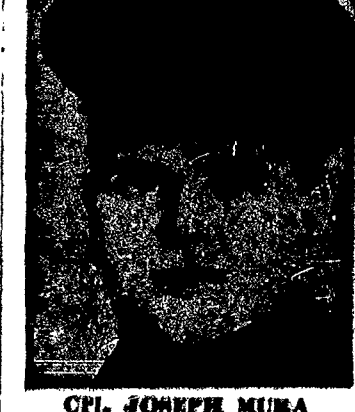

### Cpl. Joseph Mura Killed In Korea

Cpl. Joseph Mura, 21, of 86 Middlesex Rd. was killed in action near the Chosin Reservoir, Korea, on Nov. 29. It was disclosed this week.

A member of an anti-aircraft unit, Cpl. Mura enlisted in January 1948. He attended St. Ambrose School, East High Annex and Edison Tech. Prior to his enlistment he was employed by Balte Bros. and Company Bakery.

Edward, the corporals' oldest brother, served with the Army in Europe during World War II. Another brother, Richard, was with the Army in Europe and the Pacific theaters.

Surviving Cpl. Mura are his mother, Mrs. Gertrude Mura, five sisters Mrs. Evelyn Pundt, Mrs. Marjorie Walzer, Mrs. Anna Mae Frontuto, Norma and Verma Mura; three brothers, Richard F., Raymond J. and Edward R. Mura.
