THE BUSHOP made his comments during a Lenten service in St. Paul's Cathedral. He said that a "flood" of chain letters has entered this area from various parts of the United States, Europe and Australia. Most of the letters ask the recipient to copy them and mail them to nine other persons with-

in a specified time. The letters ask prayers for world peace or some spiritual grace, and frequently add that failure to keep "chain" will cause "had up the

letters which "Chain prayer and its efficacy to the number of letters sent, or to other magical factors, are sheer superstition," Bishop Wright said.

"THERE IS no room for doubt concerning, the position of the Roman Catholie Church on chain latters

"No one who understands either the nature of prayer or its exalted place in the spiritual life of a Christian, will give any whatsoever to the claims made by persons who send chain letters, however well-intended they may be.

"The world greatly needs prayers and all Christians instinctively ask the prayers of devout people. But no sensible will pay any attention to shain letters. They should be promptly thrown in
