"THE ACTUAL charge involves a number of babies who died after being brought to the orphanage," declared the Very Rev. Thomas S. Walsh, Vicar General of the Maryknoll Fathers. "The Loting orphanage was founded solely to care for abandoned bables. Ninety per cent of the infants brought there are so far spent from exposure and mainutrition that they die within a few hours. Of those that live another 70 or 80 per cent are blind."

Father Walsh declared that the Loting orphanage is located in a famine and flood belt where annually thousands of bables, mostly girls or deformed children, are religious as well as worldly cul- abandoned immediately after birth because their parents cannot feed them. 
