### Dante Fragment Found In Vatican

Vatican City, (NC) — A fragment of a page from the original of Dante's Divine Comedy with his own handwriting was discovered in the Vatican library.

Professor Riba made the important discovery when he was examining a very old codex (manuscript) known to be a fragment of a work of Dante of the first half of the 14th century.

He proved it was Dante's handwriting by a chemical examination of the ink and by comparison with the only other certain manuscript of Dante's fragment containing part of the Divine Comedy describing Beatrice's eyes, a rough marginal drawing of the hands which also proved to be Dante's work.

In the reports, George Chesbro, area director of the department summarized data submitted by Miss Vivian F. Beckman, R.N., who made a survey of the hospital in accordance with the provisions of the Social Welfare Law. Mr. Chesbro acknowledged appreciation of the cooperation, hospitality and courtesy shown Miss Beckman.

ADMINISTRATION policies were thought to be well organized and centralization of authority good because of the interest of the governing board, according to the report.

Dr. Stewart was also told that "Housekeeping standards throughout the institution are very good. There is evidence of good rapport between employees and staff." It was noted that nursing techniques seemed satisfactory for the safe care of patients and that all patients looked comfortable and contented.
