Mark 60 Years In Society Of Mary

Two former Rochesterians in the Society of Mary, a teaching order of nuns and brothers, will mark their 60th Anniversary during this year of 1951. They are the Very Rev. Bernard P. O'Reilly who entered the Order in 1891 and was ordained to the Holy Priesthood at St. Stanislaus College, Paris, April 14, 1903 and Brother Joseph Wiszicki who made his first profession of vows on August 30, 1892.

Both have established outstanding records in their years of service. Father O'Reilly is present pastor of Mary Help of Christians Church, Fairborn, Ohio and Brother Wiszicki is retired.

Brother Joseph spent his entire life in teaching from the day after Christmas in 1892, when he received his first assignment in Winnipeg, Canada, until his retirement. He has taught in schools at Pittsburgh, Cincinnati, Cleveland, Baltimore, Washington and Brooklyn. His sister, Anna resides at 18 Thayer St.

(Continued from Page 1) ing new talent, indoctrinate young writers, directors and actors in ways to inoculate innocent-sounding plays and movies with Party-line suggestions.

"Hollywood producers," he continued, are an insensate lot. Some of them are no match at all for the sly propagandists schooled in Communist cells. They do not foresee the overall effect of a steady stream of movies into which Party-line parallels have been injected. It endangers our national security—for it is now later than we think!

"We can shut off all the Reds and their shooz," he added, "only when the public makes articulate its refusal to buy entertainment with which such malcontents are connected."

MOORING MENTIONED several films which he said contained evidences of Communist techniques, including "Born Yesterday," "Bitter Rice," "Mission to Moscow," "The 13th Letter," "Halls of Montezuma" and "The Steel Helmet."

"Born Yesterday," which he cited as a vivid example of "the light, indirect touch by which characters are made symbols of class struggle and a leftist line of social comment is developed," he admitted is "artistically brilliant and, for many, highly entertaining."

He urged that the public watch for movies "which undermine Christian and traditional standards of morality; exaggerate national disunity by playing up differences between Negroes and Whites; Jews and Gentiles; tend to ridicule our form of government; in presenting an invitation to tear and follow up with an implicit plea for appeasement."

MOORING BECAME INTERESTED in movies as a cub reporter in England. He related how he was married in the Church of England "because it was the respectful thing to do." He headed the public relations department of the British International Picture Studios before coming to Hollywood in 1932 to work on the Academy award film "Cavalcade."

Verdi's 'Requiem' Slated On Eastman Theater Stage

Two hundred fifty voices will perform Verdi's "Manzoni Requiem" at Rochester's Eastman Theater on Friday night, April 27, in commemoration of the 50th anniversary of Verdi's death.

The Rochester Oratorio Society, under the direction of J. Theodore Hollenbach, will sing the dramatic Requiem in Latin, with four outstanding soloists. A 54-piece symphony orchestra will provide the musical background.

REPORTED TO BE the most ambitious production yet undertaken by the six year old society, the Requiem music moves swiftly in an atmosphere of tense emotion. Powerful and forceful, it changes from anger to grief, from terror to awe, from passion to pathos. The "Libera Me" is particularly dramatic.

Following its first performance in Milan, the work was hailed as one of the greatest ever composed, and Johannes Brahms stated that "only a genius could have written it."

Soloists with the Oratorio production include Miss Dolores Harvey, rising young Rochester soprano studying at the Eastman School of Music; mezzo-soprano Miss Frances Lehnerts of New York City, who has appeared in several metropolitan operas and on radio and television; tenor William McGrath of New York, who has had a similar career; and bass soloist Yi-Kwei Sze, native of Fund-Hwa, China, widely acclaimed for appearances in opera and in Cuba.

Trapp Family Plans Four 'Sing Weeks'

New York—Six hundred persons, including many family groups are expected to participate in "holidays of music-making" this Summer during "Sing Weeks" to be conducted by the world-famed Trapp Family Singers at Stowe, Vermont.

To be featured during the period from Aug. 6 through Aug. 16 will be a special "Liturgical Week," with daily studies of Gregorian chant led by Msgr. Martin Hellriegel, pastor of Holy Cross Church, St. Louis, Mo.

Secular music, from folk tunes to choral masterpieces will highlight the other periods, which are July 9-19, July 23-Aug. 2, Aug. 20-30.
