(Continued from Page 1) ... group has received. MR. DMYTRYK told the House Committee that he was a member of the Communist Party in 1944 and 1945. He refused to answer questions on this point in 1947. He completed a basic six-month term in jail by actually serving four months and 17 days. On his reappearance before the Committee, he said the Alger Hiss case, the case of Judith Coplon, exposure of atomic spy activities in Canada and the United States and the Red invasion of South Korea have convinced him that communism is a menace.

The former Hollywood director, who named more than a score of Hollywood figures as having been members of the Communist Party or members of organizations the communists used, said the Communist Party has three objectives in Hollywood: 1. To take advantage of the large dues and assessments it could collect in that wealthy community. 2. To gain prestige from the activities of the party itself from the work of "front" organizations that could collect large sums from persons not suspecting their motives. 3. To serve to "take over" the industry through its guilds and craft unions and then to infiltrate the motion picture themselves.
