

Montgomery, Ala. — (NC) — A new 162-bed hospital, creeted at the cost of \$1,500,000, was opened to public inspection in the City of St. Jude, near here, by the Rev. Harold Purcell.

Equipped with thirteen operating rooms and the most modern conveniences, the hospital will be dedicated in November by Bishop Thomas J. Toolen of Mobile inder whose patronage the City of St. Jude has been built.

It was to aid the Negro people that Father Purcell came to Alabama 16 years ago and set out to build a "city" that would provide better health and educational facilities for Negroes. He dedicated his project to St. Jude, "the Saint of the Impossible," and selecting a site three miles from the city, proceeded to build a community with the aid of coluntary donations from thousands of people of all faiths. The City of St. Jude now has a large administration building, a church, a grade and high school building with an enrollment of more than 1,300 students.
