

## Diocesan Film Library Popular Feature With Teachers

One of the many aids to improved teaching in diocesan schools sponsored by the Office of the Superintendent of Schools is that of the Diocesan Film Library. This important asset to the educational efforts of the Diocese of Rochester was established three years ago and has proved highly popular. Extensive in American school systems throughout the country the use of films, film strips, and projection slides has come to be accepted as necessary adjuncts for classroom instruction.

Essential to the success of

the visual aids program is the purchase by the school of adequate equipment. Ideal facilities for a school would embrace a 16 mm. standard sound projector, a slide and film strip projector. Recent surveys of the diocesan schools indicate that splendid progress has been made to date in the purchase of such equipment. When it is not convenient for the parish to make outright purchase of equipment, appeal is made to parish organizations, PTA and Mothers' Clubs, to sponsor the educational aid for the children of the school.

Since no one school can afford an adequate film library of its own, a diocesan film library has been established to serve all the schools of the diocese. This central distributing agency for visual aids has its headquarters at the Immaculate Conception School in Rochester.

### Film Library

The Diocesan Film Library is under the Direction of a committee composed of teaching sisters from various religious communities. It is the work of the committee to aid in the building up of a library of

films and other visual aids for use in the schools.

The compilation of a catalogue of available films has been an outstanding contribution of the committee.

The number of teachers availing themselves of the facilities of this splendid educational resource is constantly growing. The Diocesan Film Library in a period of three years has amply justified its establishment as an important part of the diocesan educational program.

Graduation exercises will be held in the school auditorium at 2:30 p.m. Friday, June 8 with His Excellency Bishop Kearney presiding.

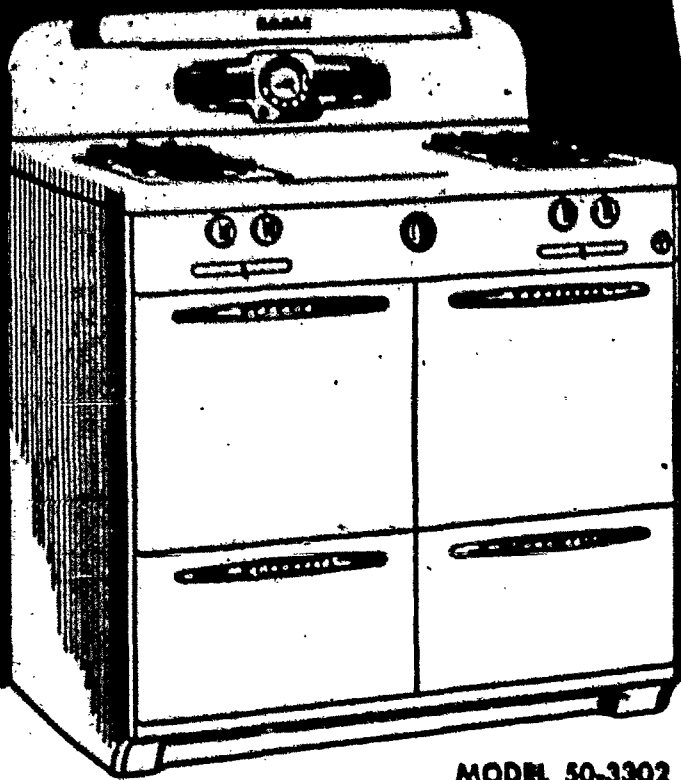
