**Bishop Federal To Receive Niagara University Degree**  
 Niagara University, N. Y.—The Most Rev. Joseph Lennox Federal, D.D., Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of Salt Lake City, the Very Rev. John A. Flynn, C.M., president of St. John's University, Brooklyn, and the Hon. William J. Small, superintendent of schools in the city of Niagara Falls, will receive honorary degrees at Niagara University's 94th commencement exercises on June 10, according to the Very Rev. Francis J. Meade, C.M., Ph.D., LL.D., LL.M., president of the university.  
 Bishop Federal will receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree. Father Flynn will be the recipient of an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree, while an honorary Doctor of Pedagogy degree will be conferred upon Mr. Small.  
 Father Meade also said that Bishop Federal would give the baccalaureate sermon and that Father Flynn would deliver the commencement address.  
 BISHOP FEDERAL, a native of Greensboro, N. C., attended Belmont Abbey College, Belmont, N. C. and Niagara University, 1929. He studied at the Albertinum University of Fribourg, Switzerland and the North American College in Rome, where in 1934, he was ordained by Archbishop Joseph Falca.  
 Bishop Federal took post-graduate work at the Pontifical Gregorian University from 1934 to 1935, receiving his Licentiate in Sacred Theology in the latter year. He returned to the United States in the same year.  
 Father Flynn is a native of Philadelphia. He attended Roman Catholic high school, that city, St. Joseph's College, Princeton, and St. Vincent's seminary, Germantown, where he completed his philosophical and theological studies. He was ordained to the priesthood in Philadelphia in 1928, by Dennis Cardinal Dougherty.  
 Following his ordination, Father Flynn was assigned to the Collegio Angelico, Rome, Italy, where in 1928, he received his Doctor of Sacred Theology degree.  
 Father Flynn served as professor of dogmatic theology at St. Vincent's seminary from 1928 to 1933 and for the following two years held a similar post at St. Bernard's seminary, Rochester. He served as a professor at Niagara University from 1935 to 1936 and as a professor of Sacred Scripture at St. Vincent's hospital visitors.
