Priest Deplores Parental Failure In Sex Education

Washington, (NC)—Smart parents are failing in their duty to give proper sex instruction to their children because they consider it embarrassing and shameful, a prominent Catholic psychologist said here at a meeting of Trinity College alumnae.

FATHER VAN DER VELDT explained that the sex impulse is a normal phenomenon and causes in every growing child a curiosity that demands explanation. "On turning, naturally, to his parents for this information," the priest continued, "the child finds—sometimes at an amazingly early age—that his parents are ill at ease or even horrified at the very mention of the word 'sex' (the child then concludes that something is wrong with the whole idea of sex and will very likely seek

their advice in the matter no longer. "As his valid request for knowledge is refused satisfaction, either he retreats within himself, where the seeds of sexual maladjustment develop, or he turns to some source of information other than his parents—a source which is too often corrupt if not altogether vicious."
