Maryknoll Sends Father Hilbert To Buffalo Post

The Rev. Charles P. Hilbert who celebrated his Silver Jubilee of Ordination, Sunday, in St. Peter and Paul's Church, Rochester, has been assigned to Buffalo to represent Maryknoll in the Western New York area, according to the Catholic Foreign Mission Society at Maryknoll.

He is one of 75 Maryknoll Missioners assigned to new posts at home and overseas in the past few days.

A VETERAN of nearly 25 years of mission work in China, Father Hilbert returned to the United States last year. Since then he has been assisting the Home Missioners of America by serving as novice master at their novitiate in Glenmary, Ohio.

Before he entered Maryknoll in 1923, Father Hilbert attended St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's seminaries in Rochester. He was ordained to the priesthood 25 years ago this month, on June 13, 1926.

In September of 1926 Father Hilbert left for the missions of China. For many years he served as rector of Kaying Seminary, training young men for the native clergy. In addition he edited "The Southern Star," one of the few Chinese-language mission magazines in Asia.

Father Hilbert has two brothers and a sister who live in Rochester: James C. Hilbert of 146 Normandy Ave., Edward J. Hilbert of 450 Pullman Ave., and Mrs. Karl Vogt of 249 Herald St.
