Departed Members of Year**

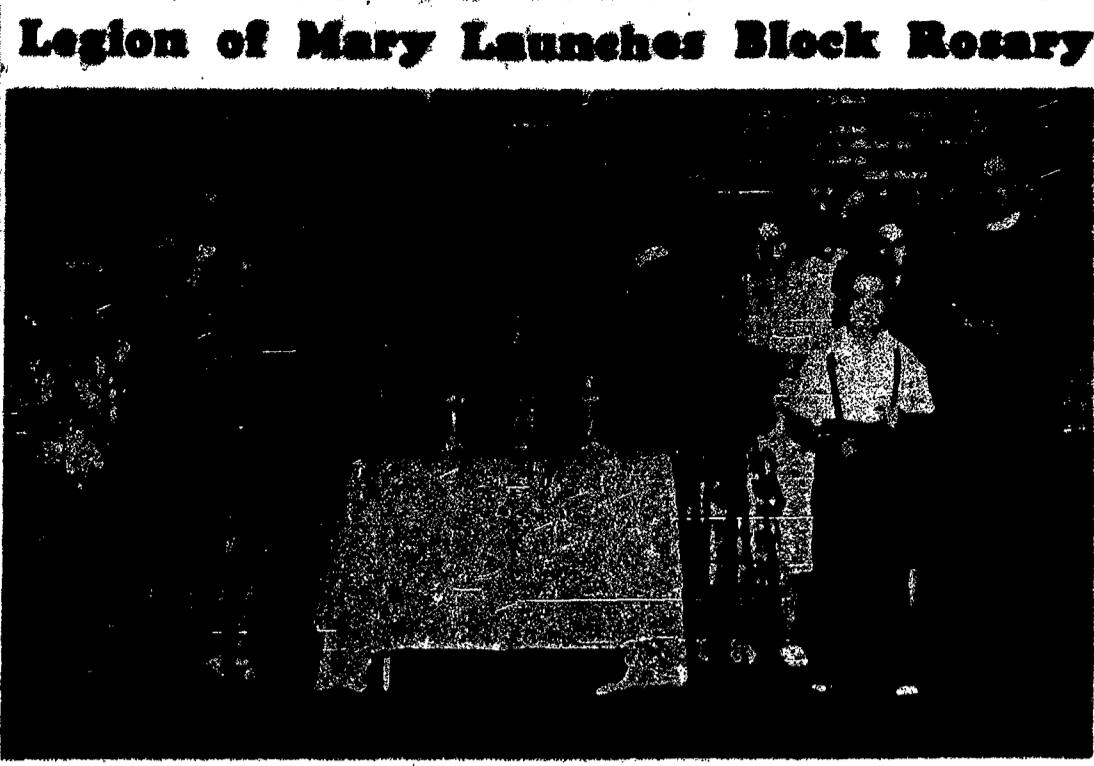

Marine Corporal William J. Flynn, Jr., a former Aquinas Institute and Monroe High School student has won the Bronze Star for "heroic achievement in Korea."

Son of Mr. and Mrs. William J. Flynn of 1130 Park Ave., the 21-year-old Signal Corporal was awarded the medal for operations against the enemy last November.

The citation reads: "Although subjected to accurate enemy small arms, machine gun and mortar fire, he fearlessly remained at his position which the enemy had infiltrated. With complete disregard for his own safety, he then advanced, with the other men of his sector, in a counter-attack against the enemy positions."

Flynn recently wrote his mother that he expects to be home this September. His three-year enlistment expired last February.

**M. G. McInerney Paid Tribute By KC At Funeral**

Funeral services for Michael G. McInerney, 83, of 4 Willowbank Pl., who was injured fatally Saturday, June 30, 1951, when his car struck a raised manhole cover in Troup St., were conducted from the Broderick Funeral Home and St. Peter and Paul Church, Rochester, Tuesday, July 3.

Mr. McInerney held a Knights of Columbus membership of the longest duration in Rochester. His initial membership dates back to 1899. He was past president of the Claretian Ducks Company, a Baltimore and Ohio subsidiary. Mr. McInerney was the former superintendent of the old Buffalo-Rochester-Pittsburgh Railway. He was associated with the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad for 50 years prior to his retirement in 1937.

He is a brother of the late Attorney John J. McInerney and of the late Detective William K. McInerney. His daughter, Eileen, is a member of the staff of the Catholic Family Center.

Celebrant of the Requiem Mass was the Rev. Robert J. Fox, assisted by the Rev. Richard C. Nangle, subdeacon. Also present in the sanctuary were the Rt. Rev. Msgr. F. William Slaughter, Very Rev. Msgr. Gerald C. Lambert and the Rev. Arthur E. Ratigan.

A delegation of Rochester Council Knights of Columbus attended the funeral.

The Rev. Bartholomew J. Quirk gave the final blessing at the grave in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

Surviving besides his daughter are his wife, Mrs. Josephine Maseath McInerney, and another daughter, Mary J. McInerney.
