

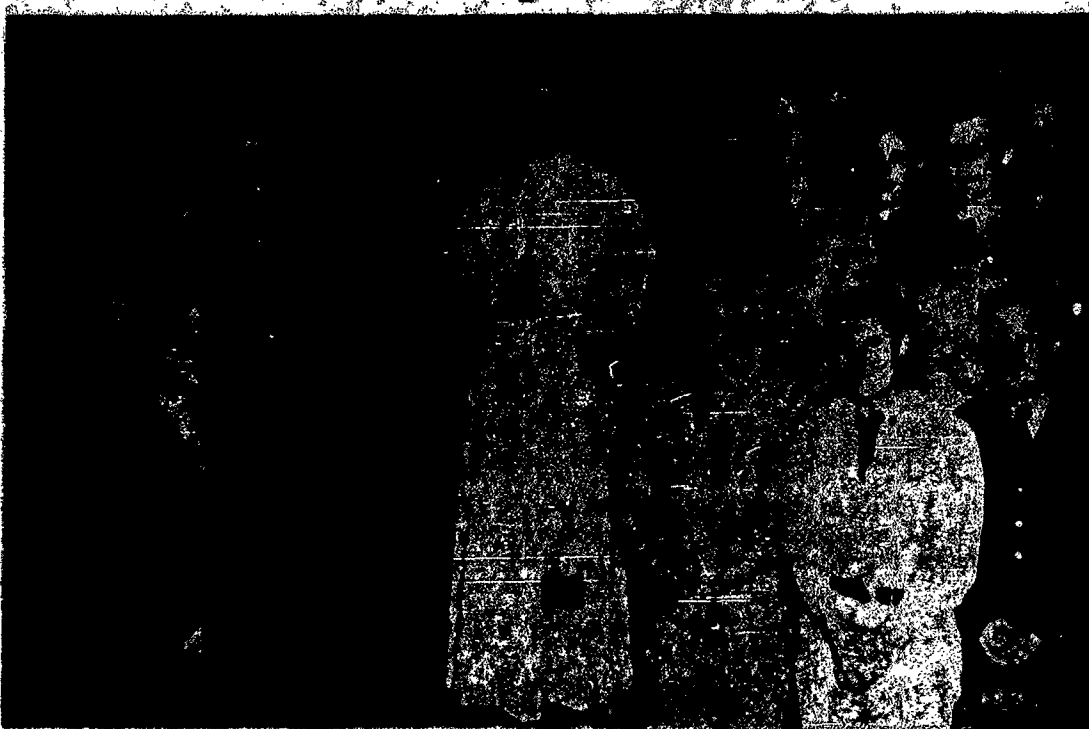
Gregorian Course At Nazareth Set To Open July 12
