Red Cross Warns Of Food Poisons

Watch that cream puff in summer that is so tempting and tastes good, but unless it has been kept refrigerated it can pack the poison of a cobra.

Cold cuts, cream-filled foods, tartar salads and cream puffs require special handling during the warm season, the Red Cross warns. They are particularly liable to spoilage from the heat. Keep them clean, covered, and cool to stop chances of food poisoning.

Avoid leaving any perishable food outside the ice box beyond the minimum time required for preparation. Protect all food from flies and insects.

These are common sense precautions outlined in the standard Red Cross First Aid course. When abdominal pains, nausea, and vomiting follow, soon after eating, a doctor should be called immediately. Until the doctor comes give large quantities of salt water and bicarbonate of soda water.
