## Daniel Sheehan's Death Widely Mourned In Elmira

St. Mary's Church in Elmira was one time a trustee of that parish.

Mr. Sheehan was born in Ridgebury, Pa., Nov. 1, 1866, and moved to Elmira with his mother in the 1870s at an early age. He attended School 3 until reaching 14, when he became a wage earner to add to the family's limited income.

He worked on a farm for a short time and then launched his career in the dry goods field. In 1877 he entered the employ of Strauss & Samuels as an errand boy at a salary of \$2 a week.

In winter months he attended night school and later took a business course in the Miller Commercial School.

He became a salesman for Strauss & Daniels before joining the Fish & Holmes dry goods company in 1883. In January, 1888, that business was purchased by Day Brothers, with whom he remained until September of that year.
