### ter of congratulation to Arch. Msgr. Burke Dies, Former As a priest and the 25th anniversary American College Rector

Mackensack, N.J. - (NC) -Magr. Eugene S. Burke, 64, former Rector of the North American College in Rome, died here (Sept. 3). He had been ill for some time. Monsignor Burke was pastor of Holy Trinity Church here since 1935. He was on the board of directors of the diocesan seminary at Dariington NJ, and of Seton Hall University, and was diocesan director of the DP resettlement program.

BORN IN Morristown, N. J. July 31, 1887, Monsignor Burke was ordained at Rome in 1911 after studies at the North American College. After four years as a curate in Jersey City he served as a Navy chaplain in World War I and then became Vice Rector of the North American College in 1919 In 1925 he was named Rector, serving until 1935. While Rector he obtained a \$1.500.000 loan from a New York banking firm to purchase Villa Gabrielli on the Janiculum Hill, on which three modern college buildings were erected for the college. The college plant at that time, on the Via Umilta, was bad-
