## Japan Peace Pact Seen No Cure for East Crisis

condition. Its exports, though relatively high and increasing each year, are still sadly below essential imports. And the peace treaty turns it loose as a free nation to make its way in a fiercely competitive world of high and rising prices.  
The high prices would be in Japan's favor, if it were able to sell more than it imports. But with a highly unfavorable balance of trade, Japan must import far more than it can export, and seemingly will have to do so far into the future. If this process tends to send Japan "farther into the hole" each year, its conditions will worsen rather than improve.

WHERE WILL Japan's markets come from? Will it sell to the United States? Yes, but not enough to make itself solvent. And its exports to the United States must necessarily be cheap goods. Before World War II China was Japan's best customer. Will Japan be tempted, and even feel compelled, to make a treaty of peace with, and to trade with, Red China?  
These are sobering considerations. But they are inescapable possibilities, and Russia knows them as well as we do.  
Will Japan's economy decline to where its leaders will be tempted to embrace a socialist state? If so, could they devise such an economy absent of totalitarianism?  
No, Japan is not out of the woods. And neither are the Western Allies. We are taking a right step and a just step. But it is only a step. Our goal is far ahead.

Dubuque, Ia. — (NC) — Pope Pius XII has sent a personal letter of congratulation to Archbishop Henry P. Rohlfman of Dubuque on his 60th anniversary as a priest and the 25th anniversary of his consecration to the episcopacy.

## Msgr. Burke Dies, Former American College Rector

Maclean, N.J. — (NC) — Msgr. Eugene S. Burke, 64, former Rector of the North American College in Rome, died here (Sept. 3). He had been ill for some time.  
Monsignor Burke was pastor of Holy Trinity Church here since 1935. He was on the board of directors of the diocesan seminary at Burlington, N.J., and of Seton Hall University, and was diocesan director of the DP resettlement program.  
BORN IN Morristown, N. J., July 31, 1887, Monsignor Burke was ordained at Rome in 1911 after studies at the North American College. After four years as a curate in Jersey City he served as a Navy chaplain in World War I and then became Vice Rector of the North American College in 1919. In 1925 he was named Rector, serving until 1935. While Rector he obtained a \$1,500,000 loan from a New York banking firm to purchase Villa Gabrielli on the Janiculum Hill, on which three modern college buildings were erected for the college. The college plant at that time, on the Via Umita, was badly overcrowded.  
IN MAY, 1950, Monsignor Burke was named chairman of the chapel fund committee of the North American College's Alumni Association. Goal of the fund was \$350,000 for a building at the college.

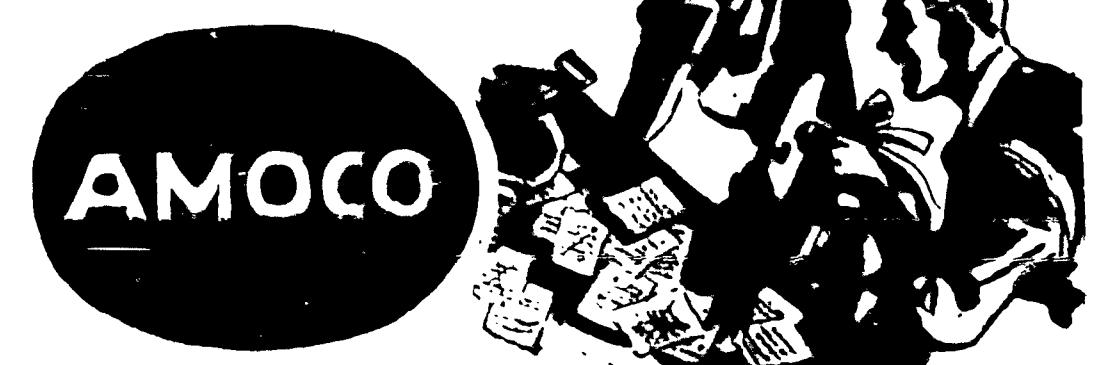
