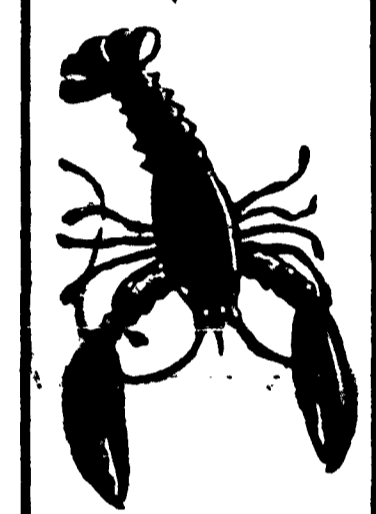

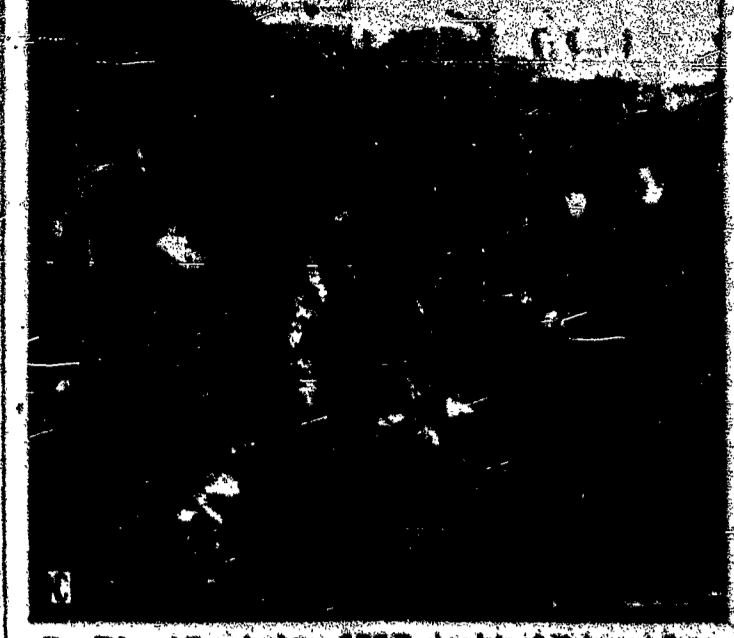

Hughes 'Doctors' Farrow Film; Indecent Ads Scored

Hollywood — (Special) — The kind of advertising Howard Hughes has ordered for "His Kind of Woman" violates at least three of the principles of the Advertising Code by which the big film companies voluntarily agree to keep their film ads decent.

Pictures of Jane Russell cut across the Code provisions that "Good taste shall be the guiding rule of motion picture advertising."

MR. HUGHES DID not get by oversight because John Farrow, whose name appears in this advertising as director of the film, not only protested against it but tried to dissuade the RKO chief from making changes in the film in order to "hop it up."
