

Two New Roads Opened To Aquinas Stadium For Game

All roads will lead to Memorial Stadium Sunday, Sept. 30, for the 2 p. m. kickoff in the 1951 football schedule of the "Lafayette Irish" of Rochester's Aquinas Institute, who will meet Notre Dame Prep School of Chattanooga, Tenn.

And a new road will make it easier for the thousands expected to flock out for the unveiling of the new Mickey Connelly's newest American football machine.

With the recent opening of LaGrange Avenue Extension, from Driving Park to Electric Avenue, three highways now approach the 25,000-capacity stadium at Ridgeway Avenue and Mt. Read Boulevard.

Special buses will run to the stadium during the hour before the game.

Opening game ceremonies will include the spirited playing of the 70-piece Aquinas Band, again under the direction of Raymond J. Hasenauer.

Coach Connelly will present highlights of each game every Wednesday night, from 8:45 to 9 p. m., over Station WHAM-TV.

Aquinas will stage its first night game since 1946 at 8 p. m. Friday, Oct. 5, against Fork Union Military Academy of Virginia.
