



Indorsed was the report of the AFL Executive Council. which said:

". . the Federation believes that Federal funds should be made available to transport children to and from any school which meets the educational requirements of the State. When we realize that many States exempt children from the compulsory school attendance laws because they Tive too far from a school' we see little justification in not using public funds to bring these children to school.

"We further hold that as the State must permit any parent
