## Marine Gets Silver Marksmanship Badge

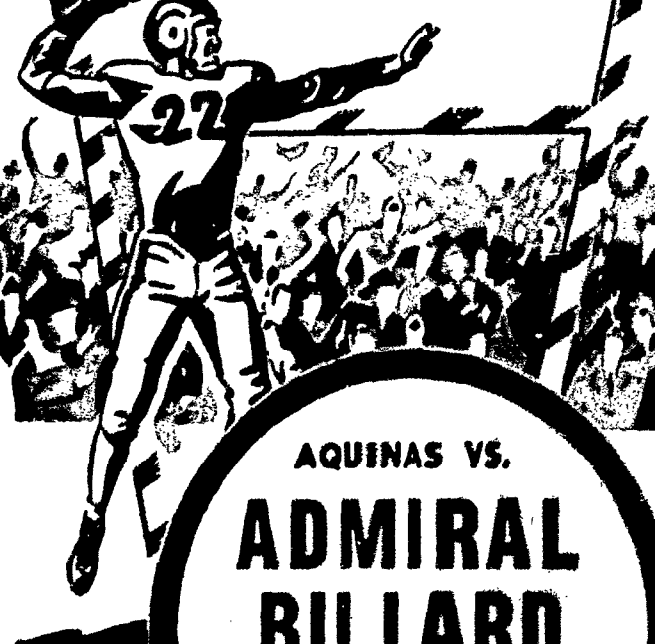
