This mailing must take place before Nov. 15 and the earlier the better, the Postmaster said. Parcels for delivery in Japan, Korea and Islands in the Pacific should be mailed not later than Nov. 1. Christmas cards should be mailed before Nov. 15 and must be sent in sealed envelopes at the first class rate. Regulations cover size and weight of parcels, preparation that is, proper packing, postage, addressing, registry and insurance services, use of or money orders and articles prohibited.
