Life Of Dr. Wu To Open Book Reviews At Library

The selection of Dr. Wu's autobiography is a timely one in view of the fact that Dr. Wu is the first speaker of the 1951-52 Christian Culture Series sponsored by the Auburn Knights of Columbus.

The eminent Chinese scholar, currently professor of Law at Seton Hall University, will appear in Auburn for his lecture engagement Thursday, Nov. 29, at East High School Auditorium. His topic then will be: 'The Spirit of Joy.'
