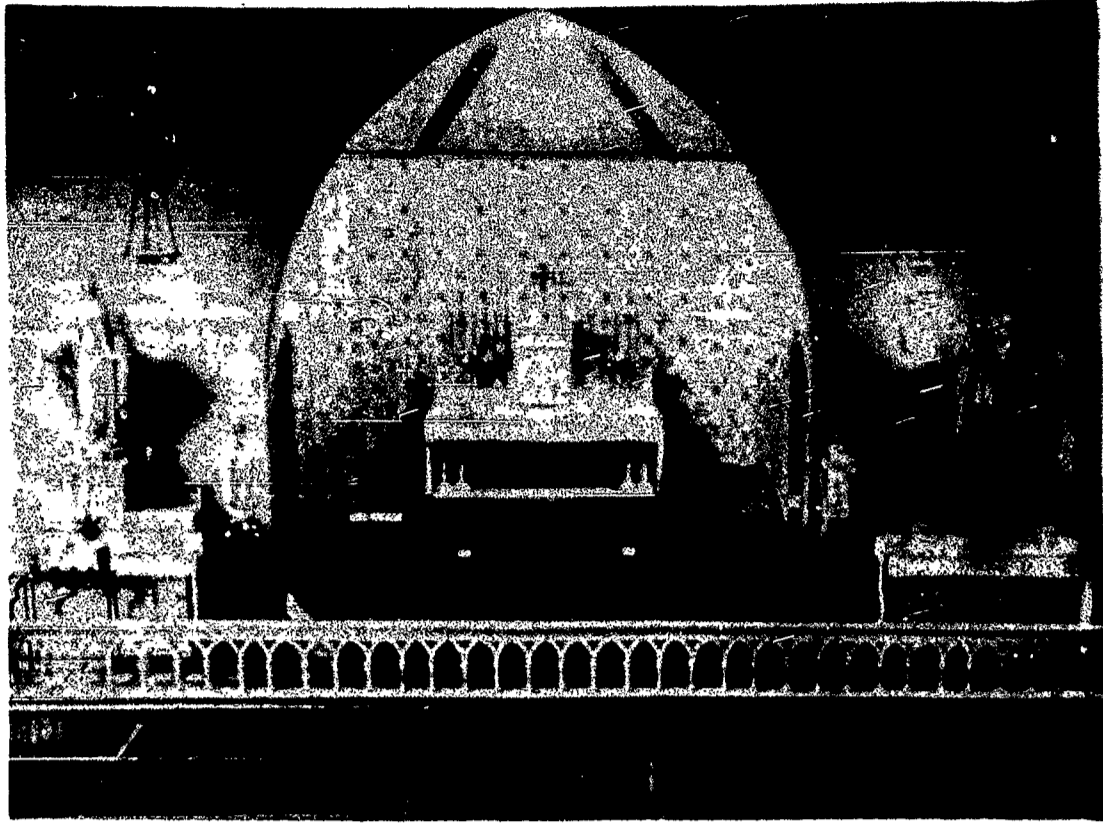


Completely Redecorated in Hilton

Transformation Of Hilton Church Interior Hailed

Planned when the parish was changed from a mission to a full parish in June 1946, redecoration of St. Leo's Church, Hilton, is now completed, the Rev. John L. Maxwell, pastor said today.

Father Maxwell was appointed pastor by His Excellency Bishop Kearney after leaving the Navy as a chaplain with the rank of lieutenant commander in 1946. In the program of parish organization was included the plans for church redecoration.

Excuted by R. Attinai and sons the refurbishing of the Hilton church has received the admiration of parishioners and visitors.

New electrical fixtures have been installed and the sanctuary has been remodeled to give the church an entirely new appearance.

STATUES OF Saints Peter and Paul and the four Evangelists have been moved from their original location in the sanctuary and placed upon corbels attached to the upper side walls. This has served to modify and simplify the altar structure more in keeping with the relatively limited sanctuary space.

An intricate pattern of gold leaf on the sanctuary walls and a paneled apse with gold striping and appropriate symbols upon a background of blue serve to focus attention upon the main altar and tabernacle.

Amber colored lights provide a subdued yet adequate lighting of altar and sanctuary. In the nave wrought iron lantern-type fixtures enclosed in amber glass are suspended from the paneled ceiling.

A LIGHT BUFF treatment of side walls in a stippled pattern blends with woodwork of a slightly darker hue. Main and side altars are of a pattern with wood work while the sanctuary railing is finished in a lighter tone.

The overall effect is of a light yet subdued interior focusing to the sanctuary highlighted in gold leaf.

St. Leo's Church before Father Maxwell took charge had been a mission of St. John the Evangelist Church, Spencerport.
