**New Pastors Appointed To Cohocton, Naples Parishes**

His Excellency Bishop Kearney has announced appointments of new pastors for two area parishes.  
The Rev. Herbert L. Sturmer has been appointed pastor of St. Pius Church, Cohocton. Father Sturmer, present pastor of St. Januarius Church, Naples, and St. Matthias Church, Atlanta, succeeded at Cohocton the late Rev. William F. Frank, who died Oct. 8.  
The Rev. Henry C. Bleier has been appointed pastor of St. Januarius Church, Naples, and St. Matthias Church, Atlanta, to succeed Father Sturmer. Father Bleier has been assistant pastor of Holy Cross Church, Ovid.  
The appointments are effective Tuesday, Oct. 30.

**FATHER STURMER**, born in Rochester, attended St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries and was ordained June 6, 1925. Before being assigned to Naples he served in the parishes of St. Peter and Paul, Elmira; St. Andrew's, St. Francis Xavier and St. Michael's, Rochester, and St. John the Baptist, Elmira. He was named pastor of the Naples and Atlanta parishes in 1936.

**FATHER BLEIER**, born in Rochester, attended St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries and was ordained June 11, 1927. Before being assigned to Ovid he served in the parishes of St. Francis Xavier and Holy Family, Rochester, and St. Vincent's, Corning. He was named assistant pastor of Holy Cross in Ovid in 1938.

**Benedictine Prior Outlines Aims To Corning KC**

Corning — Speaking before Corning Council, Knights of Columbus, their ladies and friends last Thursday night, the Very Rev. Damasus Winzen, O.S.B., prior of the Mount Saviour Monastery, now in the process of development between Elmira and Catoon, described the hopes and plans of the community.  
Father Damasus, formerly of the Abbey of Maria Laach at Koblenz, Germany, was introduced by the Rev. Ralph Neagle, chaplain at Bath Veterans Facility who is also chaplain for the local organization.  
Coming to the United States in 1938, Father Damasus served as chaplain of the Benedictine convent of Regina Leda at Bethlehem, Connecticut, besides fulfilling duties as author, lecturer and retreat master.

**SINCE ARRIVING** at the site of the new Monastery last April accompanied by three other monks, the Rev. Dom Gregory Borgstedt, formerly prior of Portsmouth Priory, R.I., the Rev. Dom Placid Corney OSB also to Portsmouth Priory, and Dom Bernard Burns, OSB, a native Elmira, work on the project has gone steadily ahead.  
On August 6 the Monastery was blessed by His Excellency Bishop Kearney. At that time ground was broken for the Chapel of Our Lady which Father Damasus said, he hoped to be completed during the next year.

Father Damasus traced the history of the Benedictine Order and explained that the monks follow the teachings of St. Benedict and work the land for their own living. The Mount Saviour Monastery will serve as a retreat center for this area. He also reported that since April the community has been increased by six novices and postulants.  
Thursday night's event was in charge of Paul Hammaro, past grand knight Col. John I. Spreckelmyer of Bath, grand knight, presided.
