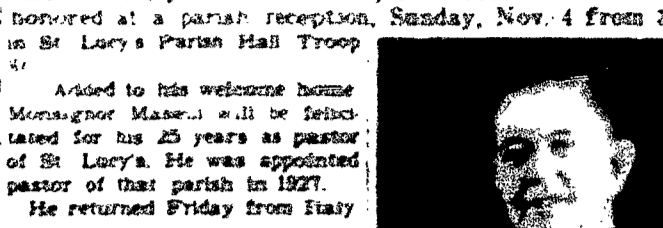
Sister Veronica Funeral Services Held At Nazareth
